Dear Mr. James:

The Department of Health and Mental Hygiene, having reviewed the information submitted in your application and considered comments from the Fisheries Administration, has approved your request to use Sonar 5P for aquatic plant control in Allen Pond, Bowie, Prince George's County, MD and hereby issues Toxic Material Permit No. TMP-87-91 to City of Bowie, 2614 Kenhill Drive, Bowie, MD 20715.

Based upon the approval of this State Agency, you are hereby granted permission to use Sonar 5P subject to the following conditions.

1. The Sonar 5P will be used solely in the aforementioned pond and in strict adherence to the recommendations of the manufacturer. The application will be by broadcasting and the quantity to be used shall be the minimum amount required to accomplish the desired results.
2. The application of the Sonar 5P will be supervised by Mr. Russell James, Aquatic Biologist, ECOSCIENCE.
3. Dead fish and/or vegetation must be removed from the pond and shall be disposed of on land in such a manner that will not create a nuisance.
